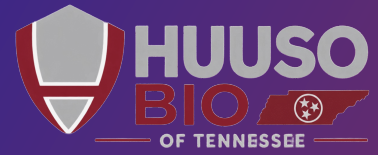


A Family Resource Handout

One printable sheet to help a family find crisis support, victim advocacy, financial assistance, and next-step resources after a traumatic death or violent crime.



1 First: immediate safety and emotional support

Life-threatening emergency

Call **911**.

Suicide or emotional crisis

Call or text **988**. Tennessee crisis services are available statewide.

2 Victim advocate

All 32 Tennessee District Attorneys General have victim-services staff. Victim Witness Coordinators can assist with rights, court information, restitution, compensation, and referrals.

3 Financial assistance

Eligible victims and families may qualify for Tennessee Criminal Injuries Compensation.

Up to \$3,000 cleanup

Up to \$6,000 funeral/burial

\$34,100 overall max*

*For crimes on or after July 1, 2025. Program rules and payer-of-last-resort requirements apply.

Families may need guidance on death certificates, probate, insurance, property access, and professional biohazard cleanup.

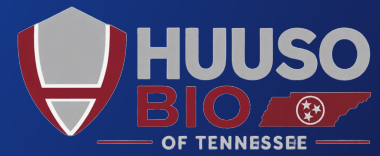
